▪ **December 21 - Official launch of the new INCCA Member Administration website**

Just one more week and the new INCCA Member Administration website will be officially launched. Through this website members will be able to:

- create and edit their own records for the INCCA Database for Artists' Archives
- search the INCCA Database for Artists' Archives
- update their contact details
- search for other INCCA members

In the past, members have had to use a cumbersome software program to deliver records to the database. Now, with the new Member website, database records can be quickly and easily entered online and records are uploaded to the database for immediate access.

The new member website is a great step forward for INCCA as it allows members to have more control over the, when and how they deliver their information. New features have also been built into the presentation of the database such as better searching tools, a list of the 20 most recent records, My favourites records and so on. An added bonus of the system is that members are able to search for and contact fellow members, through the list of member details. More information with the launch next week.

A number of members have already signed up to the system and have been testing it over the past few months. However, next week it will be available for all INCCA members.
