



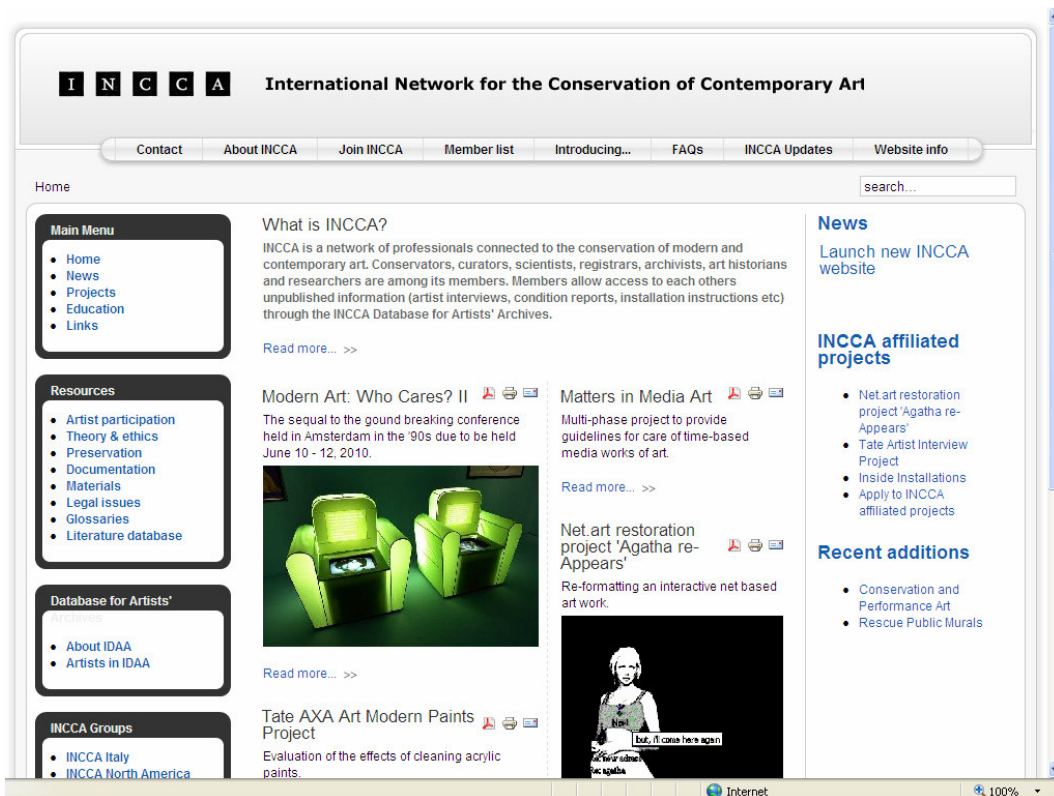
## INCCA Update – November 12, 2008

#### New INCCA website due for launch next month

Below is a sneak preview (print screen) of the homepage of the new INCCA website which is due for launch around December 15. This website has an improved menu system including easier and faster access to good practice resources. It also has a much cleaner and more modern look than the old website. The biggest change (and improvement) however is at the so-called back-end of the website. The information is now organised using a free open source content management system software called Joomla!. In practice this means that information can be uploaded from anywhere, online and not (as in the past only locally from ICN).

The URL will of course remain the same [www.incca.org](http://www.incca.org) and hopefully the transition to the new site will go without any problems. Updates and more information about the launch will follow soon.
